

Top Dogs



Ages : 8 to 99



2 to 3 players



Contents : 64 cards showing different dogs and their 2-syllable names: Lucy, Nina, Clara, Megan, Panpan, Charly, Nolan and Kevin



Aim of the game : To win as many cards as possible by the end of the game.



Playing the game:

Shuffle the cards and deal them out to all the players. The players hold their cards face-down in their hand.

All together, they turn over the first card in their hand and place it in the middle of the table so that everyone can see it. The first player to say a correct name wins the round.

To make a name, players will need to follow the instructions shown on the cards and use one syllable from each.

If there is a number "1" in the star, players must use the first syllable of the name, and if there is a number "2", they must use the second.

If 3 people are playing, a single name should be made using 2 of the 3 cards placed down.

Example A:

Kevin “1” and Clara “2”
= Kera



If the 2 cards both show the same number in the star, players can use the correct syllables from each name in whatever order they like.

Example B:

Kevin “1” and Clara “1”
= Kecla or Clake



Battle cards:

- If the syllables on the 2 cards make the dog's original name (e.g.: Lucy 1 and Lucy 2 = Lucy), it's time for a battle.
- If multiple players say the right name at the same time, it's time for a battle.

During a battle, players all play at the same time: they place a card face-down on top of the card they have already turned over, then another card face-up on top of that. Once again, it's a race to say the right name and win the round...

All players take part in battle rounds.

End of the game

The game is over as soon as a player has no cards left in their hand. The player with the most cards wins the game.
